Our Guest Speaker will be from the Delaware Center for Inland Bays, Melina Vella. Melina is the Data Coordinator and Project Manager for their new initiative, the Southern Delaware Coastal Resilience.

The Center for the Inland Bays seeks to preserve, protect, and restore Delaware's Inland Bays and their watershed. The Center achieves this through science-based: research, restoration, education, outreach, public policy, and advocacy.



The Center is launching their collaborative initiative with community members and organizational partners all across Southern Delaware aiming to develop a shared vision of what the Inland Bays will be in 50 years, called the Southern Delaware Coastal Resilience Plan.

Over the course of the next year, Center staff will be meeting with groups of community members around Sussex County to gather insight into the priorities regarding climate change and coastal resilience across the Inland Bays watershed, from road flooding to loss of wildlife habitat, they hope to explore the environmental priorities of the communities of southern Delaware.

Ideally, they want to find ways to support all of our watershed communities in combating these issues by doing what we do best—implementation of nature-based solutions and local policy changes.

We will also have quick updates on timely topics that SPC has been following closely.
