- 938 square miles, or 600,320 acres
- Approx. 256,000 residents

1970

- Delaware instituted an Administrative form of government, giving individual counties more authority to legislate and govern themselves (AKA "home rule").
 - "Home Rule" is a misnomer because the State can rescind the authority given to the County.
- Agriculture was and is the leading economic driver; farmers did not want government telling them how to use their land (AKA "property rights").

Today

- The wave of new residents from out-of-state suburban settings is changing Sussex politics.
- "Motor Voter" means nearly 80% of eligible Sussex County residents are registered to vote.

SD – Senate District

- Electoral constituency that elects a member of the Senate in the Delaware General Assembly
- **RD** Representative District
 - Electoral constituency that elects a member of the House of Representatives in Delaware General Assembly
- ED Election District
 - Territorial subdivision of the RD for electing members to a legislative body




- 18 years old or older

- Sussex County Council comprises five seats representing singlemember districts within the county.
- Each member is elected from within his/her district and serves a four-year term.
- These districts are updated through a redistricting process every 10 years, following the release of the U.S. Census results.






The Future Land Use Map, 2045



Responsibilities

P&Z COMMISSION

©2024 LWVSCDE, SPC, & Sussex 2030 1. Following the codes and ordinances set forth by the County Council, the appointed P&Z Commission has the authority to grant or deny subdivision applications.

P&Z receives and evaluates:

- State's PLUS Report (Preliminary Land Use Survey)
- Subdivision applications
- Developer's Comments
- Public Comments
- **2.** P&Z is an autonomous group. They report to no one, not even the Public.
- **3.** They act as an advisory board to the County Council.

Hearing & Public Record

P&Z COMMISSION

- **P&Z Meetings** are usually two Wednesdays a month.
- The public is allowed to speak for 3 minutes on any topic that the P&Z Commission has control.
- Public Hearings are held for standard and cluster subdivision applications.
- Public Comments are added to the record by:
 - Mail P&Z Office, PO Box 417 Georgetown, 19947
 - Email to <u>pandz@sussexcountyde.gov</u>
 - By speaking during Planning & Zoning public hearings
- Public Record typically is closed at the end of the public hearing for that application.

- P&Z Staff coordinate inspections of properties—including investigating public complaints—to ensure compliance with County codes.







To request an absentee ballot, track your ballot, or learn more about the absentee process, please click here.

To vote absentee you must qualify for one of the reasons listed below:

· You are in public service or are a spouse or dependent living with or accompanying the person in public service. This also applies to members of the Uniformed Services.

· You cannot make it to the polls due to the nature of your business or occupation. This includes people providing care to a parent, spouse or child living at home and requiring constant care; students; and otherwise eligible people who are incarcerated.

- · You are sick or temporarily or permanently physically disabled
- You are absent from the district while on vacation
- · Due to the tenets or teachings of your religion
- You are temporarily living outside the US or are a spouse or dependent living with the person living outside the US (if you choose this reason you will receive a full primary ballot, however, you will only have the Federal Offices on your General Ballot).

If you choose options 1, 3 or 6 above, you have the ability to make yourself a permanent absentee voter by checking the box on the request form.

You can check the status of your affidavit and your ballot here. Absentee ballots for School Board Elections have a separate application process. You can start here.

How to Vote in Person if Vote-by-Mail Ballot was Requested:


Those who requested an absentee ballot but end up voting in person: When voters arrive at their polling place, an election officer (poll worker) will confirm via the pollbook that their VBM ballot has not been returned to the Department. The voter's unreturned VBM ballot will be voided, and they will be allowed to vote in person at the polling place.

Overseas citizens and U.S. military personnel can find information on how to register to vote and request an absentee ballot at the Overseas Vote Foundation.






- Absentee ballots are mail-in ballots.
- They currently require an approved excuse such as work, health, vacation.
- To request an absentee ballot, you can apply online or complete a paper affidavit and mail or hand-deliver it to the Dept. of Elections.
- Affidavits no longer need to be notarized.

Status of Election Legislation

VOTING IN DELAWARE

Bill Description	Bill #	Status
Early Voting	HB-38	Passed into law; effective Jan. 2022. Challenged in 2024; DE Supreme Court ruled that the law remains for 2024 general election. Open for challenge in future .
No Excuse Absentee Ballot	HB-73	Did not pass.
Same Day Registration	HS-1 for HB-25	Determined unconstitutional in 2022.
Vote-by-Mail	HB-175	Determined unconstitutional in 2022
